

Denver Senior Amateur Competitors:

Below addresses situations on the Overland Park Golf Course that you will/may encounter in this year's Denver City Amateur (DSA) competition primarily due to the construction on the course.

Addendum to the Notice to Competitors - 2023 DSA

1. Mandatory Ground Under Repair (GUR) relief:

For a Ball known or virtual certain to lie in the following GURs, play is prohibited.

Holes 1, 2 & 3: Hole 1 right and behind putting green, Holes 2 & 3 right of the General Area from the white line to the boundary fence is GUR. Reference point for Mandatory GUR Relief under Rule 16.1 is the estimated point where the ball last entered the GUR; the player is prohibited from entering the GUR area.

Hole 3: from fenced area left of putting green to the Hole 4 Teeing Pad or the white lines surrounding the area. Reference point for GUR Relief under Rule 16.1 is the estimated point where the ball last entered the GUR; as an additional relief option, the player may use the nearest Drop Zone from the reference point.

Hole 10,12: Fenced in areas are GUR: Mandatory relief under Rule 16.1 is for lie of ball, area of swing or stance.

2. Immovable Obstructions:

Temporary fencing (Usually Orange)

Supporting Guy wires are obstructions (Example back of Driving Range)

There are no TIOs.

3. Driving Range:

Is Out of bounds as defined by white lines surrounding it. There is no free relief for interference by the driving range fence (Net) and supporting poles. Supporting Guy Wires on the course are Immovable Obstructions.

4. Carts:

Due to demand each group will be allowed a maximum of 2 carts. Spectator carts will not be allowed.

5. Changed hole yardages:

11th hole: Bronze 300 yds, Gold 286 yds and Black 250 yds.

13th hole: Bronze 427 yds, Gold 398 yds, and Black 392 yds; it will play as a par 4.

6. Model Local Rule for Lost Ball or Ball Out of Bounds:

Not in effect.
